TRAVEL COMPENSATION & GUEST RELATIONS

RAD Torque Raceway looks to welcome all of its travelling competitors, crew, friends, and family within any and all of our annual events. We view our establishment as our home, and eagerly await your arrival. The management / operations team within the facility would like to welcome its class competitors with a minimum and prorated compensation allotment for their efforts and commitments put forth by our competing teams within the 2025 Nite Thunder Dirt Oval racing series. (CAN-AM & Extreme Cup only)

- Travel distance between the range of <u>250 mi 500 mi</u> will receive the minimum allotted funding for travel/appearance compensation to the sum of \$150.00 CAD.
- Travel distance between the range of <u>501+ mi</u> will receive the allotted funding for travel/appearance compensation to the sum of \$300.00 CAD.

The funding allocated toward the travel time and competition vehicle appearance will be prorated based upon distance travelled. The funding allocated toward the team / owners is based on the location where the competition vehicle / car hauler will begin its travels from, rather than its home destination or shop space. If the start of travel is the same location as the home destination or shop space, the previous statement does not apply.

All persons claiming a Competition Driver Credential or a Competition Crew Credential, MUST sign and complete the online smartwaiver found on the RAD Torque Raceway webpage or upon the following link. <u>https://radraceway.com/waiver/</u> The Competition Crew Credential holder MUST be an essential part of the crew / racing team, while guests utilizing the General Admission Spectator passes may NOT be within any 'Hot Zones' within the racing facility.

EVENT / RACE FORMATTING - CAN/AM (MAY 9/10)

Event structure and main event formatting for the CAN-AM series event held at RAD Torque Raceway will include the following items that is to the attention of the participating teams in attendance.

FRIDAY - May 9, 2025

- <u>Qualifying:</u> Each Driver will take part in a drawing to determine qualifying position. Within qualifying, each driver will receive **two (2)** laps, where the better of the **two (2)** laps will determine starting position for the Heat Race. If a driver misses their window qualifying position drawn, they will receive a single (1) lap at the end of standard qualifying.
- <u>Heat Races</u>: Heat Race lineups will be determined based on qualifying lap times. The top 4 drivers will be inverted within the field. Passing points will be awarded during the Heat Races, where points from the Heats + Qualifying times will determine starting positions for the feature events. Points management and allocations are conducted via the CAN-AM Series group.
- <u>Main Event / Friday Feature</u>: The feature race starting lineups will be determined by the finishing positions from the previous Heat Races. The Main Event will be set to a 20 lap race.

SATURDAY - May 10, 2025

• <u>Qualifying</u>: Each Driver will take part in a drawing to determine qualifying position. Within qualifying, each driver will receive **two (2)** laps, where the better of the **two (2)** laps will determine starting position for the Heat Race. If a driver misses their window qualifying position drawn, they will receive a single (1) lap at the end of standard qualifying.

- <u>Quick Time</u>: The driver with the quickest lap time within Qualifying will be awarded the sum of \$200.00
 CAD provided by RAD Torque Raceway
- <u>Heat Races</u>: Heat Race lineups will be determined based on qualifying lap times. The top 4 drivers will be inverted within the field. Passing points will be awarded during the Heat Races, where points from the Heats + Qualifying times will determine starting positions for the feature events. Points management and allocations are conducted via the CAN-AM Series group.
- <u>Main Event / Saturday Feature</u>: The feature race starting lineups will be determined by the finishing positions from the previous Heat Races. The Main Event will be set to a 30 lap race.

Compensation allocated toward the CAN-AM held at RAD Torque Raceway on May 9/10, 2025 will be provided by the facility and partners which will be allocated to the racer's in competition by RAD Torque Raceway management / office team only. The total event / weekend purse will be set to the sum of **\$18,500.00 CAD** (\$17,000 allocated by RAD Torque Raceway + \$1,500 allocated by Alberta Extreme Sprints)

Compensation allotment / structure:

- Friday Feature Race Purse Allocations (26%): (1st) = \$650, (2nd) = \$500, (3rd) = \$400, (4th) = \$325, (5th 6th) = \$275, (7th 14th) = \$150, (15th 24th) = \$125
- <u>Saturday Quick Time:</u> \$200.00
- <u>Saturday Feature Race Purse Allocations (74%)</u>: (1st) = \$2400, (2nd) = \$1175, (3rd) = \$1000, (4th) = \$800, (5th) = \$750, (6th) = \$700, (7th) = \$650, (8th) = \$600, (9th) = \$550, (10th) = \$500, (11th) = \$450, (12th) = \$400, (13th) = \$350, (14th 24th) = \$300ea.

All Payouts will be based in Canadian Currency. (CAD)

To receive the minimum compensation, a driver / vehicle must take the checkered flag and complete a minimum of 2 laps.

EVENT / RACE FORMATTING - EXTREME CUP (AUG 1/2)

Event structure and main event formatting for the Extreme Cup series event held at RAD Torque Raceway will include the following items that is to the attention of the participating teams in attendance.

FRIDAY - August 1, 2025

- <u>Qualifying</u>: Each Driver will take part in a drawing to determine qualifying position. Within qualifying, each driver will receive **two (2)** laps, where the better of the **two (2)** laps will determine starting position for the Heat Race. If a driver misses their window qualifying position drawn, they will receive a single (1) lap at the end of standard qualifying.
- <u>Quick Time</u>: The driver with the quickest lap time within Qualifying will be awarded the sum of \$200.00
 CAD provided by RAD Torque Raceway
- <u>Heat Races</u>: Heat Race lineups will be determined based on qualifying lap times. The top 4 drivers will be inverted within the field. Passing points will be awarded during the Heat Races, where points from the Heats + Qualifying times will determine starting positions for the feature events. Points management and allocations are conducted via the Extreme Sprint Series group.
- <u>Main Event / Friday Feature</u>: The feature race starting lineups will be determined by the finishing positions from the previous Heat Races. The Main Event will be set to a 20 lap race.

SATURDAY - August 2, 2025

- <u>Qualifying</u>: Each Driver will take part in a drawing to determine qualifying position. Within qualifying, each driver will receive **two (2)** laps, where the better of the **two (2)** laps will determine starting position for the Heat Race. If a driver misses their window qualifying position drawn, they will receive a single (1) lap at the end of standard qualifying.
- <u>Quick Time</u>: The driver with the quickest lap time within Qualifying will be awarded the sum of \$200.00
 CAD provided by RAD Torque Raceway
- <u>Heat Races</u>: Heat Race lineups will be determined based on qualifying lap times. The top 4 drivers will be inverted within the field. Passing points will be awarded during the Heat Races, where points from the Heats + Qualifying times will determine starting positions for the feature events. Points management and allocations are conducted via the CAN-AM Series group.
- <u>Dash 4 Cash</u>: Upon completion of all Heat racing and finalized starting positions within the A-Main Feature event, the top 6 within the starting grid will be selected to run a "Dash for Cash". This event is an eight (8) lap race, where the final positioning at checkered flag will officially determine the A-Main Feature lineup. The Winner of the Dash will receive **\$400.00** on behalf of RAD Torque Raceway.
- <u>Dice Roll</u>: Within the intermission of the event, a fan within the stands will be selected at random via the event announcer. This fan will roll two dice. The combined total the dice shows will place a **\$500.00** "bounty" on the driver in the corresponding starting position. IF this driver wins the feature, the fan and driver will split the Dice Roll funds (50/50) presented on behalf of RAD Torque Raceway evenly.
- <u>Main Event / Saturday Feature</u>: The feature race starting lineups will be determined by the finishing positions from the previous Heat Races. The Main Event will be set to a 30 lap race.

Compensation allocated toward the Extreme Cup held at RAD Torque Raceway on August 1/2, 2025 will be provided by the facility and partners which will be allocated to the racer's in competition by RAD Torque Raceway management / office team only. The total event / weekend purse will be set to the sum of **\$17,200.00 CAD** (\$17,200 allocated by RAD Torque Raceway)

Compensation allotment / structure: (Tentative structure, subject to change w/ notice)

- Friday Quick Time: \$200.00
- Friday Feature Race Purse Allocations (40%): (1st) = \$1100, (2nd) = \$850, (3rd) = \$650, (4th) = \$500, (5th 7th) = \$400, (8th 9th) = \$350, (10th 11th) = \$300, (12th 20th) = \$200. If over 20 participants in the A Main / Feature event, the payouts will change into (12th Last) = \$200.
- Saturday Quick Time: \$200.00
- <u>Dash 4 Cash:</u> \$400.00
- <u>Saturday Feature Race Purse Allocations (60%)</u>: (1st) = \$1600, (2nd) = \$1250, (3rd) = \$1000, (4th) = \$900, (5th 7th) = \$700, (8th 9th) = \$500, (10th 11th) = \$400, (12th 20th) = \$250. If over 20 participants in the A Main / Feature event, the payouts will change into (12th Last) = \$200.

All Payouts will be based in Canadian Currency. (CAD)

To receive the minimum compensation, a driver / vehicle must take the checkered flag and complete a minimum of 2 laps.

All Event Payouts will be conducted through an appointed RAD Torque Raceway management official, and accounting director in attendance for the 2025 CAN-AM & Alberta Extreme Cup within a timely manner immediately following the event's conclusion. USD or CAD cheques can be made available upon request.

RULES, REGULATIONS, & POLICIES

The 2025 CAN-AM (May 9/10, 2025) & the Alberta Extreme Cup (August 1/2, 2025) hosted at RAD Torque Raceway will feature the Extreme Sportsman Sprint Car / Rocky Mountain Sprint Car class within the events. All vehicles within competition are held under the rules & guidelines set forth by RAD Torque Raceway & the Alberta Extreme Sprints group. Any/all competition discrepancies or contesting will be handled through RAD Torque Raceway's oval Director Neil Turnell, and RAD Torque Raceway General Manager; Chevy Reeves.

All teams within the property of RAD Torque Raceway are to follow the rules and guidelines set forth by the facility. Those who choose not to comply will be given a singular verbal warning. If a second offence occurs, the facility holds the right to escort and remove an individual or team off the private property via law enforcement.
